OUR LIST RESOURCES

The resources that are linked to from our website are not maintained or monitored by us. The information and links provided as resources are supplied by members of the public. We will check basic functionality of links provided and ensure that any offensive information given is removed from our records before publishing the resource.

You can add a resource via our website healthy-relationships.co.uk following the prompts given. When adding a resource we ask you supply an email address, so we can identify who is supply us links. We will store your data securely and it will not be passed to any third parties.

We cannot accept responsibility for any information contained within our site or for the contents of any links from our site to other sites. In the unlikely event that a resource has incorrect information, we reserve the right to withdraw the resource from the site. PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy describes how your personal information is collected, used, and shared when you visit or interact with healthy-relationships.co.uk (the "Site").

PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

When you visit the Site, we automatically collect certain information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and some of the cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Site, we collect information about the individual web pages or resources that you view, what websites or search terms referred you to the Site, and information about how you interact with the Site. We refer to this automatically-collected information as "Device Information."

We collect Device Information using the following technologies:

“Cookies” are data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier. For more information about cookies, and how to disable cookies, visit <http://www.allaboutcookies.org>.

“Log files” track actions occurring on the Site, and collect data including your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, referring/exit pages, and date/time stamps.

“Web beacons,” “tags,” and “pixels” are electronic files used to record information about how you browse the Site.

Additionally when you add a resource, report a resource or contact us through the Site, we collect certain information from you, including your email address. We refer to this information as “Person Information.”

When we talk about “Personal Information” in this Privacy Policy, we are talking both about Device Information and Person Information.

HOW DO WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

We use the Person Information that we collect generally to monitor who is sending us information and if needed to reduce spamming of the system.

We use the Device Information that we collect to help us screen for potential risk (in particular, your IP address), and more generally to improve and optimize our Site (for example, by generating analytics about how our customers browse and interact with the Site, and to assess the success of our marketing and advertising campaigns).

SHARING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We share your Personal Information with third parties to help us use your Personal Information, as described above. DO NOT TRACK
